This correspondence provides a status update for the re-opening of the Mt. Hope Bridge.

Dates for Activity: June-July 2018

Work Activities: Reopening of the Mt. Hope Bridge

The bridge at Mt. Hope is scheduled to re-open by the end of July.

- Masonry work on the guardrail columns will take approximately 2-3 weeks.
- Paving of the bridge surface and approaches will follow and take about 1 week.
- Upon successful final inspection, the bridge will re-open to traffic while final landscaping restoration takes place.
- Please continue to use the alternate routes until further notice.
- Fencing has been reduced around the bridge and the direct access to the barns has been restored.
- I will send out another update once the bridge is officially open for use.
