Public Parking Lot Reconfiguration

June 8, 2018

Public Parking Lot at the base of Spring Street.

This correspondence provides an update for the reconfiguration of the Public Parking Lot.

Work Activities: Construction Update:

Impact to Adjacencies:

- Providing an update to the construction in the parking lot pre-cast curb installation continues throughout the entire parking lot area. The work area will shift onto the south shoulder of Walden Street along with the west side of Spring Street as installation of granite curb begins.
- Starting on Monday, June 11, the southernmost parking bay will be blocked off and become property
 of the Inn construction site until the Inn construction project is complete in the summer of 2019. The
 other two parking bays will remain open, which will provide approximately 130 parking spaces for use,
 an increase of 10 spaces from the old lot. The entrances/exits off Spring Street and Walden Street will
 remain.
- The parking lot light fixtures are to be installed in the next few weeks and the temporary pole lights will be removed. Sidewalk and landscaping work will follow the light pole installation. To accommodate the remaining work, there may be the need to block off a few spaces from time to time, but it will be temporary and limited.
- Noise/disturbances associated with construction (back up alarms, excavations, dust, mud and trucks) should be expected.
- Additional signage and police details will be on hand as needed.
