## **UPDATED INFORMATION**

October 22, 2018

Public Parking Lot at the base of Spring Street.

This correspondence provides an update for the reconfiguration of the Public Parking Lot.

Work Activities: Construction Update: PARKING LOT CLOSED THE NIGHT OF OCTOBER 24 AND NOT OCTOBER 23 AS ORIGINALLY PLANNED.

## Impact to Adjacencies:

- DUE TO RAIN IN THE FORECAST FOR OCTOBER 23, THE PAVING OF THE PUBLIC PARKING LOT WILL NOW OCCUR ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 24. ALL OF THE INFORMATION BELOW IS STILL APPLICABLE.
- Placement of the final pavement for the Public Parking Lot will be completed on the night of October
  24.
- To perform this work, the parking lot will be closed for the entire night, reopening at 5AM on Thursday morning. Overnight parking is already not allowed.
- Starting at 7PM on October 24, the portion of the parking lot near Walden Street will be closed at 7PM. Starting at 8PM, the entire lot will be closed. No parking will be allowed in these lots after the start times. We have been working with the Town of Williamstown and the Police Department and they will assist with towing vehicles that remain after these times.
- Additional notification is being circulated to the businesses who remain open after these times to remind customers about this work.
- Signage will be placed in advance at both the entrance and the exit to make everyone aware.
- Noise/disturbances associated with construction (back up alarms, excavations, dust, mud and trucks) should be expected throughout the night.
- Further circulation of this document would be greatly appreciated.
