Lacrosse Wall Ball Wall- Update 1

February 18, 2019

Adjacent Building Occupants and users of Weston Field

This correspondence provides a status update for the upcoming construction of a Lacrosse Wall Ball Wall at Weston Field.

Our Start date has been pushed off to Friday February 22. This will not impact our completion date. Restoration of the lawn around the wall will not be completed until the Spring weather is appropriate.

Dates for Activity: February 22 – March 31, 2019

Work Activities: Construction and installation of a concrete Wall Ball Wall

Williams College is pleased to announce it will construct a free-standing wall to be used by Williams Athletics programs for lacrosse and field hockey practice.

The wall will be located to the immediate West of the Football field grandstand and be oriented parallel to the sidewalk that leads from Gargoyle Gate to the Lee Track facility. The 1 foot thick wall will be made of solid concrete and be 16' tall by 40' long.

Impact to Adjacencies:

- Dig-safe will be conducted in the coming days.
- Temporary construction fencing will be installed in early February.
- Construction traffic will access the site via Latham St. at the Gargoyle gate.
- Construction vehicles will include dump trucks, cement trucks, a truck crane and 3 tractor trailer trucks who will be delivering the pre-fab'd concrete panels.
- The sidewalk behind the grandstand will be blocked off to pedestrian traffic.
- Please plan to use the walkway under the grandstand during construction. Typical construction noise from excavators, power tools and cement trucks can be expected. The project is expected to last approximately 6 weeks.
