## NON-STANDARD WORK HOURS CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY NOTICE

North Science Addition

September 17, 2019

This correspondence provides notification of construction activity that may fall outside of standard work hours.

On Thursday September 19 and 26 the North Science construction project is scheduled to pour and finish concrete floor slabs on the upper floors of the building. The task of pouring and finishing concrete is a critical milestone subject to influences of chemistry, weather and progress of the trades, so these dates are tentative and subject to change.

The noise that may result later in the day is concrete floor finishing equipment working to level and smooth the concrete poured earlier in the day. This finishing activity, by chemical necessity, is timed in lockstep with the concrete curing process. So although the concrete will be poured starting in the morning, the finishing process may extend later in the day depending on many factors. There is the possibility that finishing work may extend into the off-hours.
